Duration:

21 months - 1 day per week

Entry requirements:

A minimum of two GCSEs at grade C (4) or above in English and Maths is desirable. A pleasant disposition, good communication skills, the ability to remain calm, and maintain confidentiality is also required. Other equivalent qualifications are acceptable.

Overview:

You would become a qualified Dental nurse approved by the General Dental Council, with the opportunity to progress onto post graduate courses in Oral Health Promotion, Radiography and sedation. There are also opportunities to progress to be a Dental Hygiene Therapist.

- Level 3 Diploma in Dental Nursing
- Functional Skills – Level 2 English and Maths
- Additional Qualification – First Aid Certificate
