Level 2 – There are no strict entry requirements, however a minimum of two GCSE in English and maths at grade C or above would be preferable.

Level 3 – A completed level 2 Heating & Ventilation Apprenticeship Other equivalent qualifications are acceptable.

In this area you would work as a pipe fitter installing and repairing heating and ventilating systems; you could be a pipe welder, or you could be an installer of ventilation sheet metal ductwork.
