



LIGHT VEHICLE MAINTENANCE & REPAIR APPRENTICESHIP

3

Duration:

36 months - 30 day release sessions each year

Entry requirements:

A minimum of four GCSE at grade C (4) or above (or equivalent) including English, Maths and a Science-related subjects desirable. Other grades may be considered.

Previous industry experience will be considered.

Overview:

You would learn all aspects of the service and repair of light vehicles along with fault diagnosis, alternative fuel vehicles and customer care. This vocation requires keen individuals with the ability to learn a multitude of skills, multi task, interpret data, problem solve and have a hands on approach.





Aim:

Successful completion of all components:

- Classroom based learning program.
- Gateway 1 assessment, skills and knowledge and behavioural tool.
- Gateway 2 assessment, skills and knowledge and behavioural tool.
- Completion of 'e' logbook by apprentice and employer/mentor.
- F Gas qualification.
- Level 3 End Point Synoptic Assessment.
- Maths and English Functional Skill (Depending on prior attainment).
