



MECHANICAL, ELECTRICAL & TRIM (MET) APPRENTICESHIP



Level:

2 & 3

Duration:

Level 2 – 24 months / Level 3 - 12 months -
Three days per month training on block release

Entry requirements:

Level 2 – A minimum of four GCSE at grade C (4) or above including English, Maths and a Science-related subject is desirable. Other grades may be considered.

Level 3 – Completed level 2 Apprenticeship or previous industry experience will be considered.

Overview:

You would work in a body shop, strip down accident damaged vehicles prior to them being repaired and rebuild them after.

You would work on both light and heavy damaged vehicles from stripping bumpers to removing engines, as well as undertaking basic diagnostic work.
