Level:

2 and 3

Duration:

Level 2 – 20 months/Level 3 – 24 months

Entry requirements:

Level 2 – There are no strict entry requirements, however a minimum of two GCSEs at grade C or above including Maths and English would be preferable.

Level 3 – A completed level 2 Plumbing and Heating Apprenticeship Other equivalent qualifications are acceptable.

Overview:

You would gain experience on the job to learn about the installation and maintenance of plumbing and heating systems and appliances. Level 3 covers gas fitting accreditation or solar hot water qualification.
